In 2002 on a very auspicious day, Ganesh Chaturthi, a family friend called and wanted to come and talk about building a Hindu temple in Corpus Christi. The initial hesitation vanished after visiting several community leaders from our Indian community. There were multiple meetings, discussions, disagreements, compromises, and finally the project became a reality. Our very first installation of deities took place in May of 2005.

Now I realize that we already have 10 years of operation under the name of South Texas Hindu Society. The community has grown. Several new members moved to the community. Hundreds of students from home are here and visit the temple very often.

My sincere thanks to him. Time and again I have tried to reel him in, to be on the board but was not successful. Having said that, we have just celebrated the 10th anniversary. Believe it or not the priests have put such an effort to arrange, decorate and coordinate the two and half day event. There are several hundreds of pictures uploaded to our website, a nice effort from our two young priests. It is very disappointing to see very few attendees. It was a weekend event but still it was not a pretty sight to see very few devotees.
